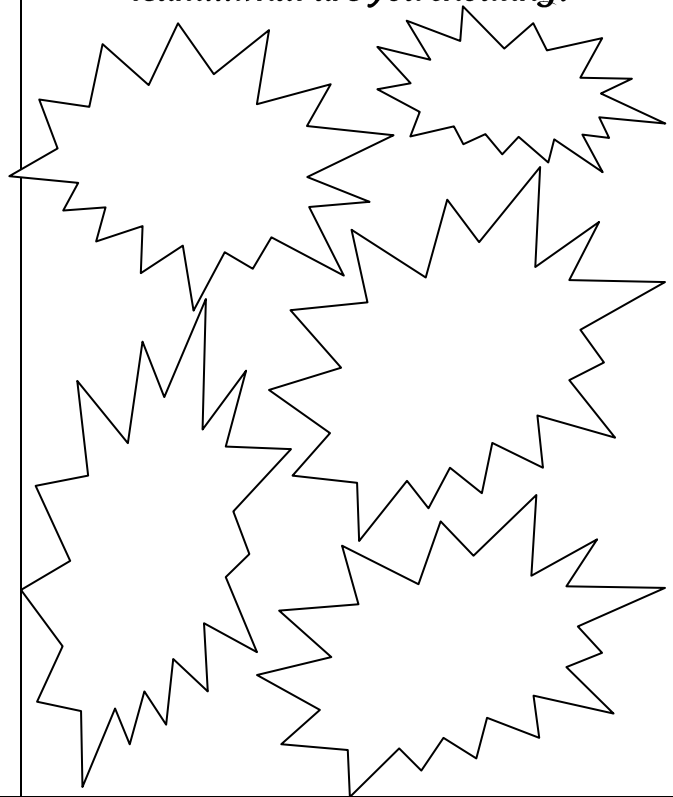

Going on a Trip?

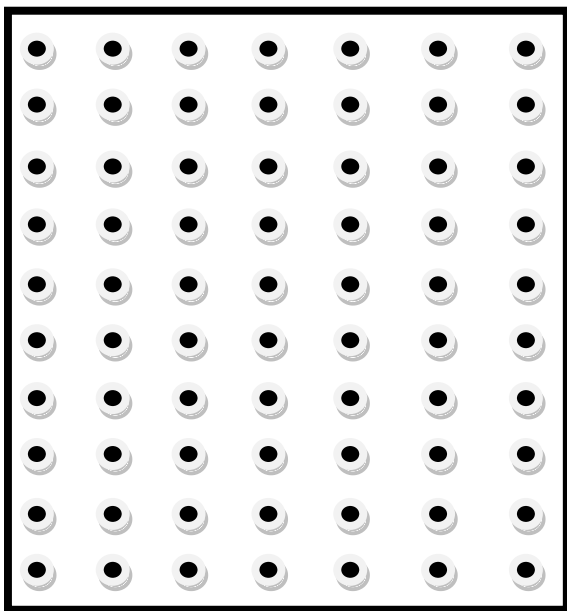
If you could visit any country in the world, where would you go, what would you see, and why do you want to visit there?

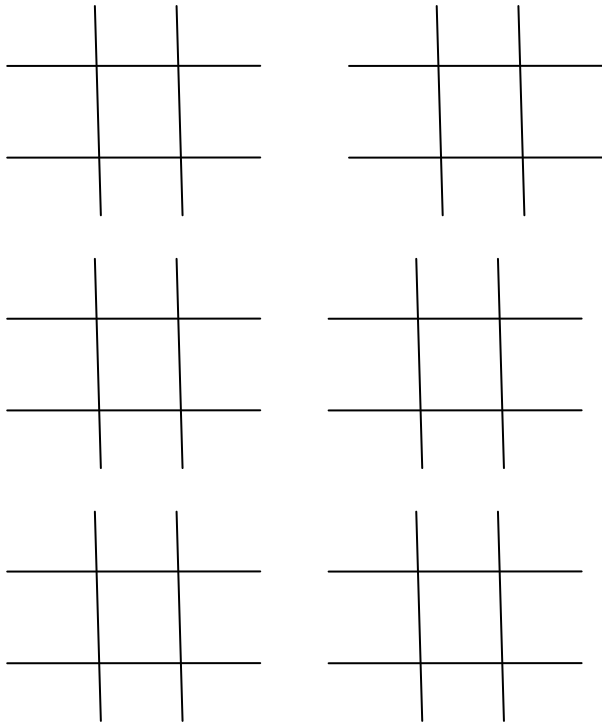

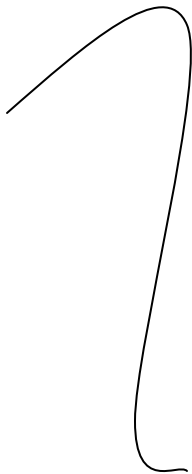

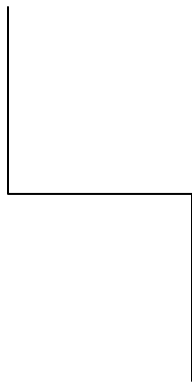
